The National Higher Education Scholarship grading system and evaluation criteria for the year of 2020/2021 in Eötvös Loránd University's Faculty of Education and Psychology

ARS

Section 110 (2) The applications shall be ranked in accordance with the principles laid down in the Special Provisions.

- (6) The applicant shall obtain the documents necessary for the application. All titles shall be justified separately with an authentic document. The document shall become authentic with the signature of the person justifying the title and with an official seal. No points may be awarded to a title that is not justified by an authentic document.
- (7) The documents that may be rectified shall be announced clearly by the Office of Educational Affairs in the faculty's call for application. The documents that may not be rectified may not be submitted after the expiration of the deadline. In the absence of the necessary documents, the application will be rejected by the faculty's decision-making body responsible for the assessment of the applications.

Section 437 (1) The ranking of the applications for the Scholarship of the Republic of Hungary is determined by a grading system. The grading system is approved by the Faculty Council based on the recommendation from the Faculty Scholarship Committee and is published on the website of the Office of Educational Affairs in the study period of the preceding semester.

The conditions for submitting and assessing the application

[The crossed out and passages marked with a * are not appliable to the requests submitted in Neptun.]

- 1. Only a complete application form can be evaluated.
- 2. *Attachments shall be handed in with the name and the chosen category in the annexed form
- 3. The National Higher Education Scholarship calculates the grade point average as follows: weighted own average x (weighted own average /faculty's programme average). In the case of parallel studies the second programme's results are not included in the average.
- 4. Students in language programmes can get points for the language exam only in case the language of the exam is not the same as the language of the programme.
- 5. Only those language exams are valid that the student has obtained in the academic year of assessment including the summer period before, and only if the applicant passed it after the end of the previous application period.
- 6. A language can be calculated only once. If the student has language exams on more than one level, the higher one can be counted.
- 7. Among the professional activities, an activity can only be evaluated on one title.
- 8. Only one activity can be counted towards a given title. Exceptions to this are those indicated in points 13, 14 and 15. Further exceptions are professional sports activities, publications and lectures (category II.: 3, 4a and 4b), where more than one activity can be submitted for a title, but the score for the title is halved for the second and further documents submitted.
- 9. Each activity must be certified by a separate document or certificate.
- 10. Only one of the professional and public activities can be taken into account at the same year of decision including the previous semester summer period, if the applicant performed it after the end of the previous application period.

- 11. The maximum points in III. category can be 50 % of what the student can get in I. and II. category.
- 12. The criterion of translation by himself or co-authoring translation is that it has to be published in a profession journal with an ISSN or ISBN number.
- 13. In the case of "any other, the profession activity of the field" (II. category, 5.f.) maximum five activities can be counted. Points can be given by activities, for the first three activities 2 points, for activities 4 and 5 1 point.
- 14. In the case of "Volunteering related specialisation" (II. category, 5.h.) and a "Non-professional Volunteering" (III. category, 4.e.) a minimum 30 hour of activity is required to get the necessary points.
- 15. In the case of "published literary and artistic art" (category III, 4.h), and "performer art presentation; performance participation" (category III, 4/i) up to three works of art can be taken into account, points can be given for each.

The student's total points are considered for the first ranking of the evaluation.

Those students with identical points are preferred:

- who has earned more points in Category of Studies and Professional activities (in category (I.+II.)
- in case of further agreement the students who has earned more points according to the average of his/her studies.
