

**Guide to submitting the application for the National Higher Education Scholarship at PPK:
Equivalence of categories of the application form in Neptun and of those found in the grading system and
evaluation criteria for the year of 2020/2021**

The application form for the National Higher Education Scholarship can be found in Neptun, in the *Administration>Requests* menu as a request titled “*National higher education scholarship – 2021/22*”. The request is uniform for the whole university, thus the contents, the sequence and the segmentation of the activity categories therein are not completely the same as the segmentation of the categories of the grading system used at PPK. The table below lists the equivalences of categories of the application form in Neptun and of those found in the grading system of PPK.

ATTENTION! In your application always indicate the identification number of the appropriate PPK grading system category before the title of a given document in the text boxes of the Neptun form.
