** According to the time of the compulsory completion of the prerequisites we define two types of them. The strong prerequisites must be completed before registering for the given course (in this case the prerequisite must be completed in the previous semester). The weak prerequisites may be completed in the same semester (but the marks in these courses must be obtained before taking the exam / obtaining the mark in the course whose prerequisites they are). Co-registration: the two courses must be enrolled in the same semester.
